## Mass Excision Post-Operative Protocol

Day 0-14	<ul> <li>No lifting greater than 1-2 pounds         <ul> <li>May do self-care activities as well as light duty work such as typing and writing</li> </ul> </li> <li>Make a fist 5 times an hour while awake         <ul> <li>Take care to avoid over-extending fingers so as to not stress the incision site. The skin on the palm of the hand is tight; wound healing problems can manifest if the wound edges at the surgical site separate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Keep hand elevated above the level of your heart</li> <li>Keep post-operative dressing/compressive dressing in place</li> <li>Keep dressing clean and dry</li> </ul>
2 weeks	<ul> <li>Remove post-operative dressing</li> <li>Email a photo of your incision to the Olson Team email address</li> <li>Stitches are absorbable     o A clear tag of the absorbable stitch may be sticking out of the skin; snip the tag of     the stitch close to your skin.</li> <li>May get steri-strips wet, but may not soak (bath tub, swimming, hot tub, etc.); pat     area dry.     o Once steri-strips fall off and incision site is fully healed, water activity is unrestricted</li> <li>Unrestricted in all activities as tolerated</li> </ul>
